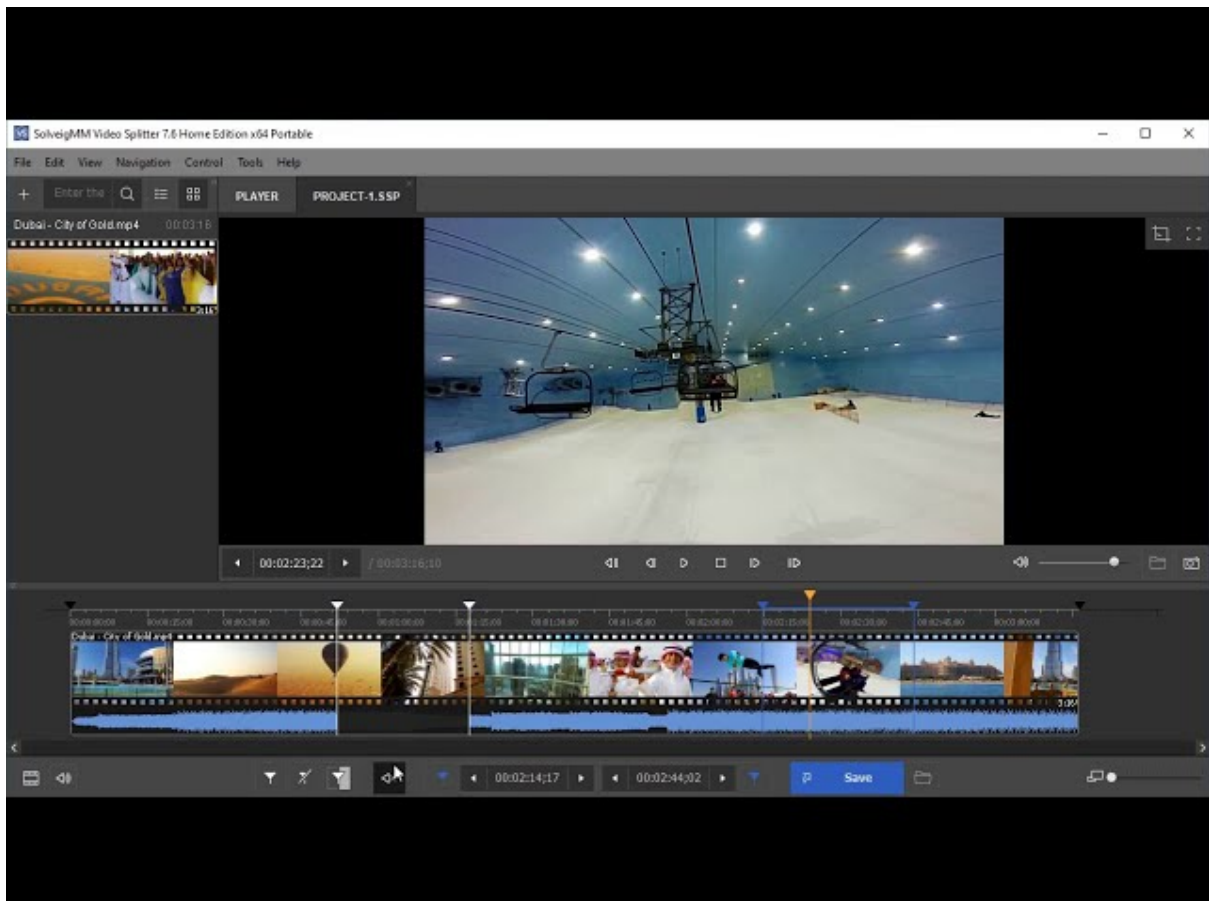


# How to mute video sound with Video Splitter

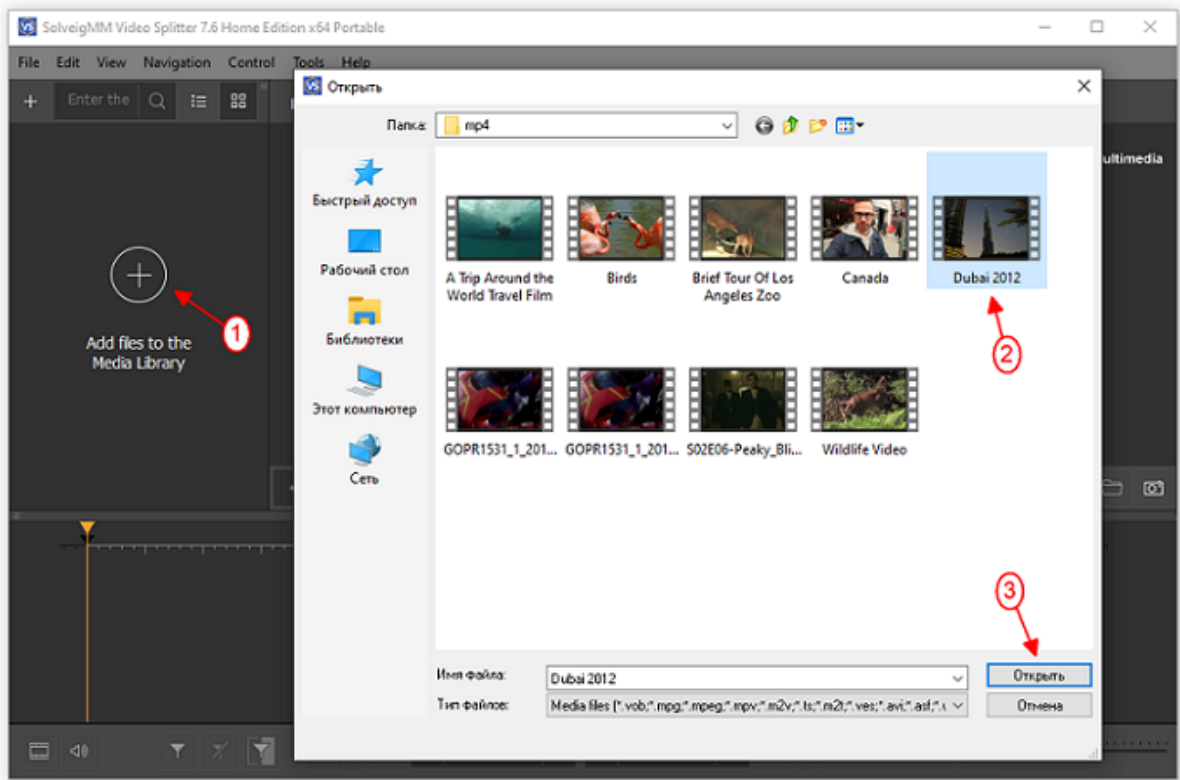
When certain parts of our video clip have broken audio or inappropriate content, we may need to remove the sound from those sections. Other times, we may just want to mute specific sections of our video clip if, for instance, we're making a video project, censoring it, or sharing it with friends on Facebook, YouTube, or another social network. Whatever the goal of your project, [Video Splitter](#) will be the indispensable and simple-to-use tool for any situation where you want to silence the sound on particular movie segments.



## [How to mute video sound:](#)

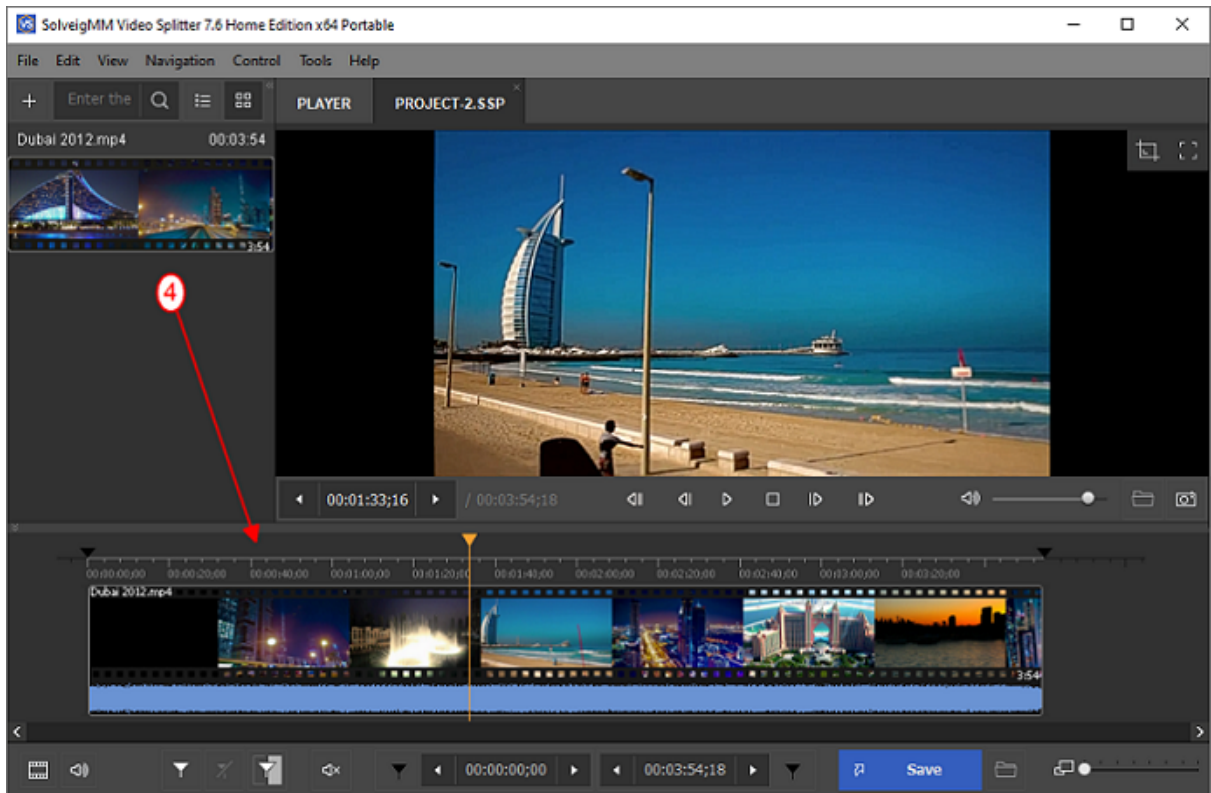
### Step 1

Launch Video Splitter and open your file. You can access it via the File menu -> Add Media Files or by using the specific "Add files to the Media Library" button on the main window.



## Step 2

Your file should be moved from the Media Library to the Timeline area.



## Step 3

Using the Video Slider and "Add marker" button, select the fragment or fragments you want to be muted. In our illustration, we muted two sections of the video.

Slide the slider to the beginning of your first fragment, then press the "M" short key or the "Add marker" button on the Video Splitter editing bar.



#### Step 4

Choose the start/stop coordinates for the second fragment in the same manner that you choose the end of your previous fragment.

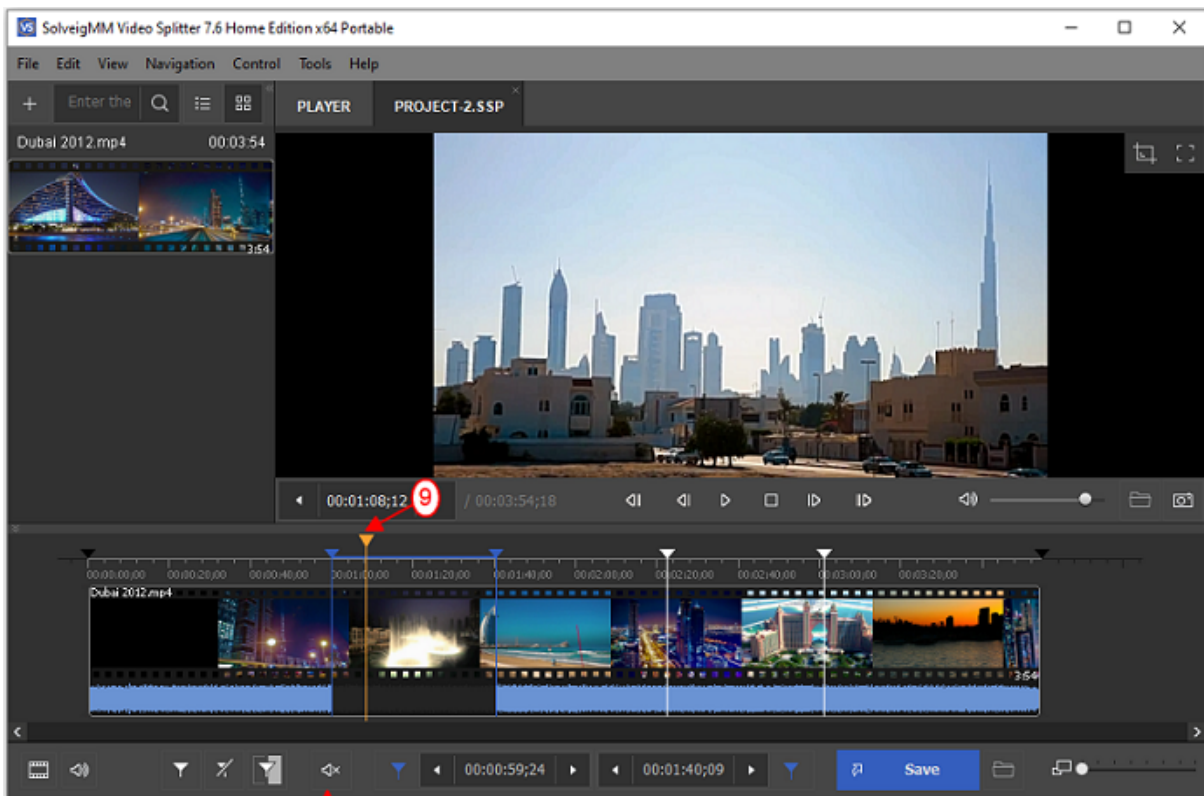


A timeline with five fragments will be given to you.



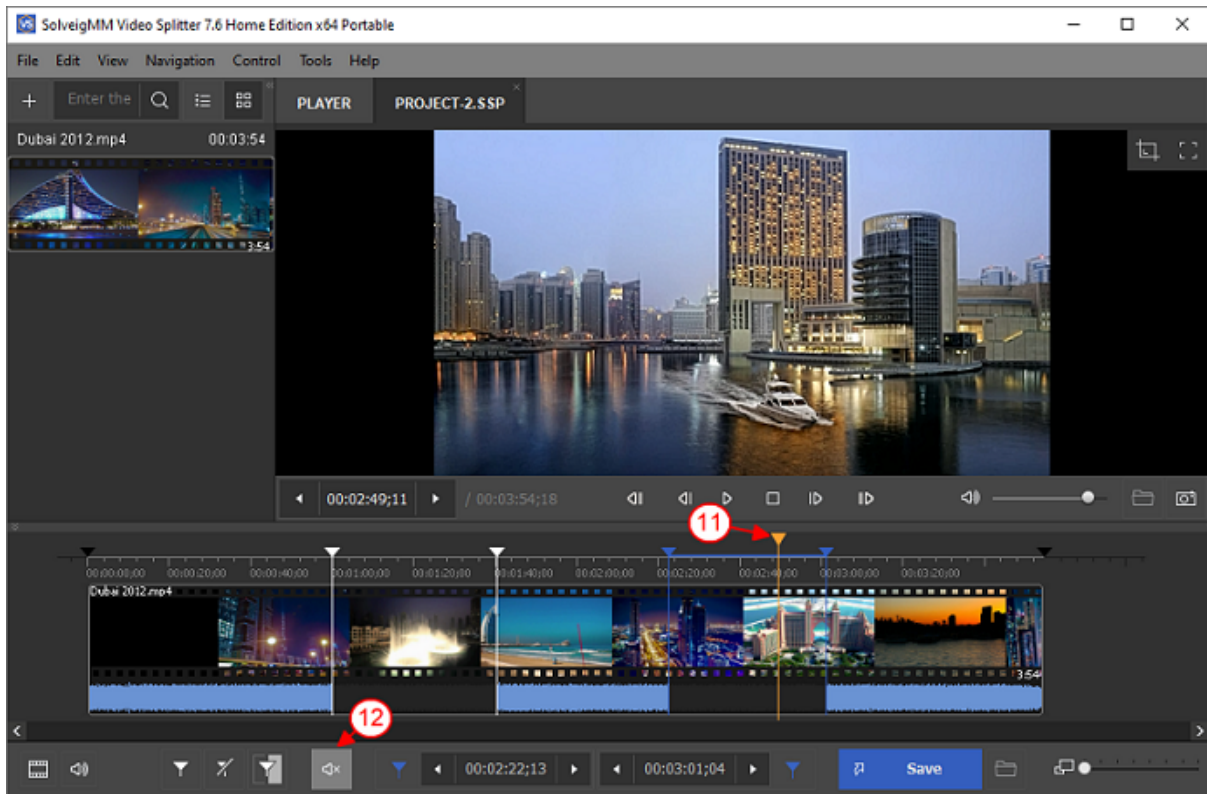
## Step 5

The fragments that you want to have no sound in the output file must now be set. Click the "Set audio silence" button after selecting the fragment with the slider (it should now be grey instead of its original color).



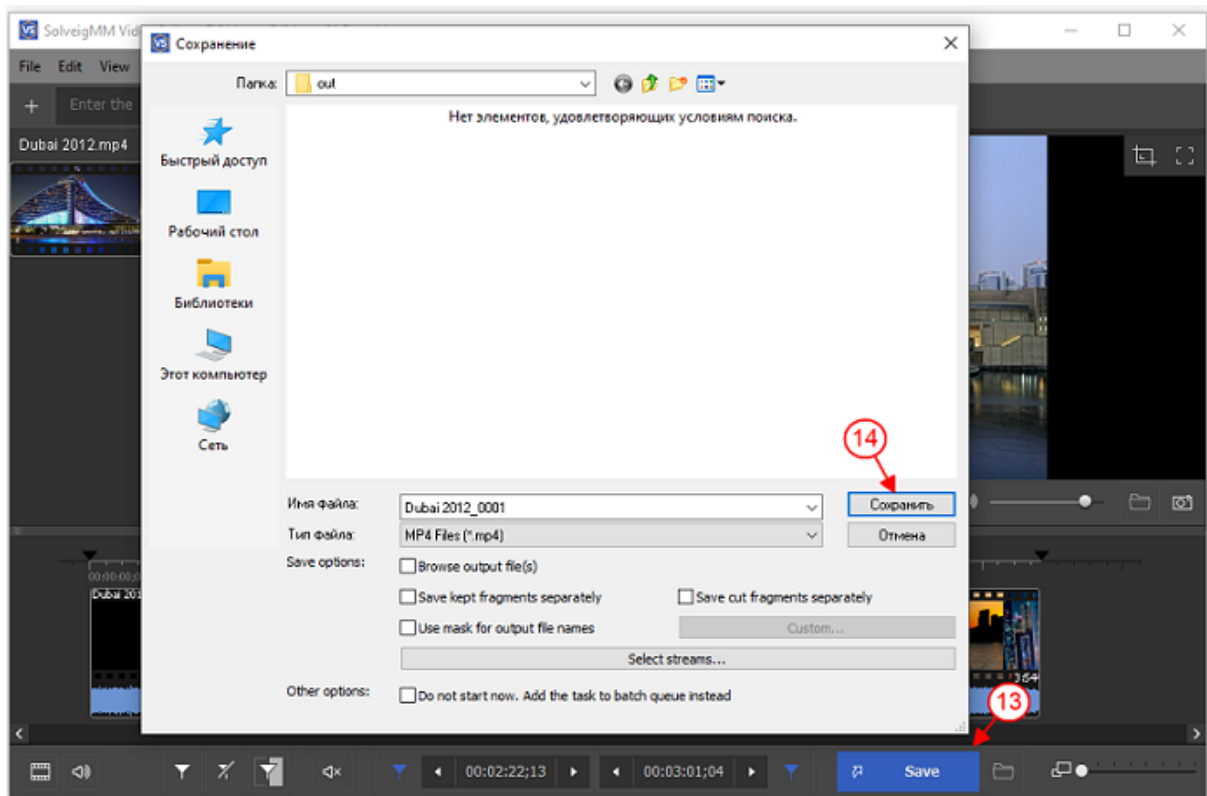
To silence the second fragment's sound, follow the same procedure as before. On the chosen fragments, the sound will be removed and replaced with quiet.

The Video Splitter window will display the following:



## Step 6

To begin editing, either click the "Save" button or select the Save... option from the "Edit" menu.



An output file containing muted fragments will be produced.
